1. Home essentials

Our hostels provide a happy and secure environment in which children threatened with abuse and violence can live and learn in peace. These are some of the essentials they need.

- 1a. Knickers and socks for 10 children £20
- 1b. Mosquito netting for one window £20
- 1c. Raincoats for five children £30
- 1d. Mattress, bedsheet and pillow £30

2. Open School

Children in our care who struggle to keep up in mainstream school can be educated in our Open School. This gives them the opportunity to learn at their own pace and to pass the exams they need to progress to further or higher education.

- 2a. Textbooks and notebooks for one child £12
- 2b. Uniform and school shoes for one child £20
- 2c. Chair and table £30
- 2d. Teacher's salary for one month £80

3. Education and training

Education is key to our work, and we support children from primary through to further and higher education, ensuring they can fulfil their potential in either an academic or vocational field.

- 3a. Tailoring classes for one month £25
- 3b. School fees for one term £75
- 3c. Block-printing equipment £75
- 3d. College fees for one term £120

4. Extracurricular activities and special events

Batemans is concerned with the whole child and our extracurricular activities help children develop confidence and self-esteem.

- 4a. Annual outing for one child £12
- 4b. Two footballs £15
- 4c. Christmas dinner for 10 children £30
- 4d. Art and craft materials for one term £35
- 4e. Karate lessons for one term £50
- 4f. Group music lessons for one term £50
- 4g. Sports day equipment and medals etc ... £120

5. New primary school and community centre

The quicker our new school and community centre is built, the sooner we can begin helping marginalised children receive the education they need.
