- 1c. Raincoats for five children£30
- 1d. Mattress, bedsheet and pillow £30
- 1e. Diwali dinner for 10 children £40

2. Open School and home learning

Children in our care who struggle to keep up in mainstream school can be educated in our Open School, which gives them the opportunity to learn at their own pace. During the coronavirus lockdown, all our children have been homeschooled to ensure they continue to make progress in their studies.
