- Promoting an active, experiential and independent engagement in their learning, developing responsibility and resilience to facilitate an adaptable approach to a changing global landscape.
- In a safe environment, we aim for children to develop high levels of communication, whether this is through the development of literacy, numeracy, IT or artistic expression.
- We offer a learner-centred bilingual curriculum that is holistic and inquiry-driven, which will develop higher-order thinking skills, criticality, and problem-solving to prepare them for future life.
- Batemans Trust aims to develop the unique character and potential of each child where they can feel emotionally secure through an advocacy of compassion and care, throughout their learning environment.

Indian School Aims

To achieve this mission we will

- Develop a curriculum closely aligned to the ideals and lawful expectations of the National Education Policy 2020
- Ensure that all pupils whatever their level of academic attainment, social situation or gender receive a high quality personalised education through a well planned/developed and resourced curriculum that reflects individual needs and matches each learners' ambitions.
- We will involve pupils in their education so that it is an experience that they help to build
- We will give pupils skills that help them to understand their responsibilities and rights and how each and everyone has a role to play in our world
- We will value an understanding of cultural heritage whilst also embracing world wide issues such as the sustainable development goals.
- We will employ highly qualified teachers who through their understanding of both child development and curriculum development will be able to extend each child's capabilities
- The school will be bilingual, teaching will be in both Tamil and English emphasis initially on proficiency in mother tongue but also with a strong learning and use of English
- We will provide opportunities for children to be able to become confident communicators who can use these skills to make well informed decisions.

- The school is initially for pre school and early primary aged children.
- The age range will grow as the school buildings develop.
- For those children already part of the trust or who join in the future who find difficulty accessing main stream senior school, support will be given to help with the achievement of the 8th standard pass and a route through vocational education which will lead to future employment.
- The two trusts support pupils who might otherwise not access main stream public education by providing wrap around care, weekly boarding or termly boarding.
- Particular consideration is given to those children of single parents, immigrants, building workers and those orphaned children who become wards of Tamil Nadu.
- The school will also meet its mission statement through the support and development of local teachers, health workers and parents.

- Liaise with Monica and Raghland over planning and registration of the school and new boarding houses
- Start promoting the new school / advertise the website seek sponsorship from companies including buying equipment
